1. Call to Order

2. Approval of Minutes

3. Coach's Report – Joe Pesci

Coach Pesci reported the fall ball is going well. Nation 9 workouts on Monday afternoons is well attended. Lifts at the PHS West gym continue to be offered on Wednesday afternoons and Saturday mornings. Next week (week of October 21) will be the last week of our fall workouts. In January the coach directed workouts at Nation 9 will begin.

Our Eagles raffle was launched this week. Out of a possible 150 chances that are available, 25 have been sold. The cost is \$20/chance.

5. President’s Report – Greg Webber

It was discussed and voted on unanimously by the board on October 7, 2024 to file an amendment to our articles of incorporation to match what is in our bylaws. This needed to be done for the application to receive state sales tax exemption.

The amendment states - Upon dissolution of this organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a local or state government, for a public purpose or to the Pennsbury School District for use in connection with the team to the extent permitted by law, with any residual amount going to support Pennsbury School District Athletes.

6. Board Members Report – Farrah Seidler

Nothing significant to report.

7. Committee Reports –

- a. Golf Outing – financials listed above. Event was a big success, and we retained our sponsorship/hole signs for next year’s outing.
- b. Bingo – 3rd annual bingo is scheduled for 2/8/25.

8. Old Business –

AWRE Camera system- the PBPC had approved the purchase, but the school (technology department) turned down the request due to internet concerns related to all the construction that will be going on with the new high school project.

9. New Business –

- a. New equipment will need to be purchased this year for the Varsity field. This includes a mower and field groomer. We are currently in the process of getting prices for both pieces of equipment.
- b. Concrete Jacking/Mud Jacking (a concrete leveling technique that involves pumping a mixture of water, sand, and soil under a concrete slab to raise it back to its original level) is being explored to repair areas of our field that are damaged.
- c. Halloween Costume Game – will take place at Morrisville Little League (MLL) on Sunday, October 27. We currently have 17 players registered. The PBPC will be selling chances for our Eagles raffle and PHS Baseball swag. MLL will be selling concessions and raffles. The plan is to rotate the location of this annual event throughout all of our youth baseball leagues.
- d. Under Armour Shop – the shop will open in the next week and all apparel will be arriving in time for the holidays.
- e. New Hats – we are placing a large order for the Black hats with the “P” on them. After distributing hats to the players and coaches, we will sell the rest to our fans.
- f. 2025 PHS Baseball Schedule – the varsity schedule has been set. The JV schedule is almost complete and working on the freshman schedule (this takes more time, and we need to wait and see which schools will field freshman teams).
- g. Upcoming Dates –
