Spring 2027 Important Dates

Spring Training Trip

- Varsity and JV teams will be attending spring training down in Myrtle Beach, SC. The trip will be a few days longer than previous years. Still working out the exact length of this trip. Planning to spend the first night in North Carolina with workouts/possible scrimmage at the USA Baseball complex. Will then head down to play at Ripken in Myrtle Beach. The approximate cost is \$1,200.00/player. We are working hard to fundraise and get the cost/player down. All money fundraised from our golf outing will go towards the spring training trip.

3. Facilities

- Due to ongoing construction at Pennsbury High School, only the varsity field will be available on campus this season.
- Multiple teams will share the varsity field throughout the year.
- Coach Pesci is working with the school on additional field rental options. Has spoken to Levittown Continental and Pennsbury Athletic Association about field use.
- Will look to stagger games and maximize use the Varsity field (freshman home games when Varsity/JV is away).
- Asking school board to consider upgrades (fencing, lights, dug outs).

4. Fall Baseball

- Fall baseball begins tomorrow, September 9th for returning players in 10th, 11th and 12th grade.
- Fall baseball will consist of training, skill development, and weightlifting only.
- PHS Baseball has access to the weightlifting room on Tuesdays and Wednesdays.
- There is no designated spot to leave baseball equipment in the high school during the day. Players should either leave their equipment in their cars, have their parents'

drop-off after school or ask a teacher if they may leave their equipment in their classrooms for the day.

- No fall games are planned.
- Players participating in a Pennsbury High School fall sport should not attend fall baseball activities.
- Participation is completely optional.
- Eligible participants include students in grades 9–12 attending Pennsbury High School, Pennsbury homeschooled students, and Tech School students.
- Fall Baseball will wrap up with the annual Halloween Costume Game on October 27, 2026, at Macclesfield.

5. Winter Baseball

- **November–December:** Weightlifting
- **January–February:** Weightlifting and Skills Training (indoor skills training locations are still being worked out. It will most likely be a combination of River Sports and All Star Sports Academy.)

All fundraisers, with the exception of the Launch Raise Fundraiser, give players an opportunity to personally fundraise and offset their expenses. Players receive 10% of the sponsorships they bring in (golf outing and bingo). In past years, players have made \$10 from every gift card calendar they sell and \$10 for every bingo ticket they sell. Major player expenses include the trip to Myrtle Beach and the Player Pack.
